COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY  
AUTHORIZATION TO SELL SURPLUS EQUIPMENT  
WITH MUNICI BID ONLINE AUCTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Winfield is desirous of utilizing the online MunicibiBid Website for the public auctions, to sell certain surplus equipment for the Township of Winfield; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-157 permits a municipality to adopt a resolution authorizing the sale of such tangible property; and

**WHEREAS**, the list of equipment is attached as Schedule A and incorporated herein; and

**WHEREAS**, by the Township Committee that these vehicles and miscellaneous equipment will be offered by the Township Clerk and Chief of Police on the MunicibiBid ([www.municibid.com](http://www.municibid.com)) online auction site to the public at a date to be announced and shall be offered for sale a public auction to the highest bidder in accordance with the law, provided that a minimum price shall be established for the items and that no bid below this price shall be accepted; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all property not bud on will be held for future auction with the date to be determined; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all such sales at public auction shall be final and payment only by certified check or money order at the time of said auction payable to Winfield Township; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the appropriate Township officials are hereby authorized and instructed to take such further steps as may be required by law to the affect such sale and auction, including the advertising of the sale of such property by other means in addition to legal notices required by law, and the establishment of a place and time where the merchandise to be offered for sale may be viewed by a potential bidder.
