Free Rabies Clinic at the Winfield Firehouse

For the safety of your pet, they MUST be on a leash or in a pet carrier!

Shots will be administered by a State licensed veterinarian. Winfield pet registrations begin in January 2023. Your pet's rabies shot <u>must</u> be valid through Nov. 1, 2023 for a license to be issued.

If your pet has not proven to be sensitive to the rabies vaccine, overlapping rabies vaccinations will not harm your pets. However, if your veterinarian does not recommend a rabies shot, you must provide a letter from your vet stating that, for a license to be issued. Failure to license your pet will result in the issuance of a summons, per violation (\$74).

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(6) Authorizes contracting units to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the County of Union, hereinafter referred to as the "Lead Agency" has offered voluntary participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the purchase of work, materials and supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Winfield, County of Union, State of New Jersey, desires to participate in the County of Union Cooperative Pricing System.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, on this 19TH day of September, 2022, by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, County of Union, State of New Jersey, as follows:

TITLE

This resolution shall be known and citied as the Cooperative Pricing Resolution of the Township of Winfield

AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(6), the Mayor and Municipal Clerk of the Township of Winfield is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Pricing Agreement with the Lead Agency.

CONTRACTING UNIT

The Lead Agency entering into contracts on behalf of the Township of Winfield shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq.) and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Municipal Clerk be and hereby are empowered and directed to execute an amendatory agreement consistent with the above.
