TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD RESOLUTION 21-44 COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NJS 40A:4-48 (Under 3% Limitation)

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen with respect to Purchase of Police Vehicle and no adequate provision was made in the 2021 Current Budget for the aforesaid purpose, and N.J.S. 40A:4-46 provides for the creation on an emergency appropriation for the purpose mentioned above, and

WHEREAS, the total amount of emergency appropriations created, including the appropriation to be created by this resolution is \$25,000 and three (3) percent of the total operating appropriations in the budget for 2020 is \$60,752 and

WHEREAS, the foregoing appropriation together with prior appropriations does not exceed three (3) percent of the total operating appropriations (including utility operation appropriations) in the budget for 2021,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, (by not less than 2/3 of all governing body members affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with N.J.S. 40A:4-48:

- 1. An emergency appropriation is hereby made for Purchase of Police Vehicle in the amount of \$25,000.
- 2. That said emergency appropriation shall be provided for in full in the 2022 budget, and is requested to be excluded from CAPS, pursuant to NJS 40A:4-53.3c(1).
- That two (2) certified copies of this resolution be filed with the Director of Local Government Services

TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD RESOLUTION 21-45 COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH JIM SHORKEY AUTO GROUP FOR 2021 PATROL VEHICLE

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen with respect to the Winfield Police Department's need for a police vehicle and as such an emergency appropriation under N.J.S.A 40A:4-46 is appropriate; and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen emergencies, that were not known at the time of the budget for the year 2021, the Winfield Police Department is now in desperate need of a police vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Winfield Police Department has exhausted all other avenues in attempting to locate, lease or borrow a police vehicle, but due to vehicle shortage and short-term loan of unmarked vehicles from another municipality which have expired, the purchase of a vehicle is the only, and the Police Chief has located a vehicle for purchase from Jim Shorkey Auto Group in North Huntingdton, P.A.; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the 2021 Ford Sport Utility Vehicle with the proper police outfit is \$33,461.14 with payments to be spread over a three (3) year term; and

WHEREAS, the initial payment due is \$25,617.84 which consists of the first payment of \$11,808.49 plus the police vehicle outfit cost of \$13,809.35; the remaining balance of the \$33,461.14 will be paid over the remaining term; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified this need and the appropriate emergency appropriation for this expenditure; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the mayor and/or Clerk be authorized to enter into agreement **JIM SHORKEY AUTO GROUP, 133 Route 30, North Huntingdon, PA 15642** for the purchase of the 2021 Ford Sport Utility Vehicle with police outfit at a total cost of \$33,461.14 with a three (3) year term.
