AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD TO RENOVATE, ALTER, DECORATE, AND REPAIR THE MUNICIPAL TOWN HALL AND PROVIDE FOR THE FUNDS FOR THE PAYMENT OF SAME.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Township of Winfield, County of Union, and State of New Jersey:

SECTION 1: That the Township of Winfield, County of Union, in the State of New Jersey, has recently completed renovation of the Municipal Town Hall so as to improve same and make it more attractive.

SECTION 2: Therefore, it is now necessary to install an adequate heating system in said Town Hall for the comfort of the employees and the citizenry of the Township of Winfield.

SECTION 3: That the proper Officers of the Township are hereby authorized, directed, and it is made their duty to transfer sufficient funds not to exceed \$1,500.00 from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township of Winfield as to pay the necessary, reasonable charges to install an adequate heating system in the Municipal Town Hall.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, recording and publication as provided by law.
