

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP  
COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD  
TO PURCHASE A 1941 MACK MODEL 505-S  
500 GALLON PUMPER WITH A SEMI-CAB FIRE  
ENGINE AND MISCELLANEOUS EQUIPMENT AND  
PROVIDE FOR FUNDS FOR PAYMENT THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Township of Winfield, County of Union, and State of New Jersey:

SECTION 1; That the Township of Winfield, County of Union and State of New Jersey is hereby authorized to purchase a 1941 Mack Fire Engine, Model 505-S 500 Gallon pumper with semi-cab, 3 pump dischargers, 2 lengths of suction hose, including one length soft suction hose, ladders, spotlights, danger lights, triple equipment rails, permanent mounted deck nozzle.

SECTION 2: That the present Diamond T Fire Truck be traded. The trade-in allowance to be no less than \$1,000.00.

SECTION 3: The estimated cost of the Fire Engine to be purchased will not exceed \$5,200.00 and there is hereby appropriated for the afore-said purpose the sum of \$5,200.00 from the Capital Improvement Fund, from monies made available by appropriations made in budgets heretofore adopted designated as Capital Improvement Fund.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, recording and publication as provided by law.
