

ORDINANCE TO CREATE A FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE TOWNSHIP OF
WINFIELD

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD.

Be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, in the County of Union:

1. There is hereby established a Fire Department for this Township which will be under the supervision of a member of the Township Committee to be chosen by majority vote of the Township Committee.

2. The said Committeeman will be known as the Director of Public Safety of the Township of Winfield.

3. The Township Committee shall make all rules and regulations to govern the Fire Department.

4. The Township Committee may provide for paid fireman as deemed necessary by the committee and may appoint officers and firemen, and may provide general regulations for the proper operation of the Fire Department.

5. This ordinance shall be effective immediately.
