FOR FUNDS FOR THE PAYMENT OF SAME.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the Township of Winfield, County of Union, and State of New Jersey:


SECTION 1: That the Township of Winfield, County of Union and State of New Jersey is hereby authorized to proceed to renovate, alter, decorate and repair the part of Municipal Town Hall known as Police Department Offices to make it more suitable for the public, officials and members of Police Department of the Township Government.

SECTION 2: That the proper officers of the Township are hereby authorized, directed and it is made their duty to transfer sufficient funds, not to exceed \$2,100.00, from the capital improvement fund of the Township of Winfield as to pay the necessary, reasonable charges for the renovation, alteration, decoration and repair of the part of Municipal Town Hall know as Police Department offices.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, recording and publication as provided by law.
