

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED  
"AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES  
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD, COUNTY OF UNION,  
AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield:

SECTION ONE: That Section 2 of the Ordinance hereinabove referred to of which this Ordinance is amendatory and which the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

No Plenary or Seasonal Retail Consumption License, Limited Retail Distribution License shall be issued in the Township of Winfield.

SECTION TWO: The annual fee for the Club License is hereby fixed at the sum of \$50.00 per year and such fee shall be payable to the Treasurer of the Township of Winfield by the holder of such license as of July 1 of each calendar year.

That no more than ONE club license shall be issued and outstanding within the Township of Winfield, County of Union, and State of New Jersey at one time.

SECTION THREE: All other parts and provisions of the Ordinance adopted June 14, 1943, not inconsistent herewith, are hereby ratified and confirmed and they shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are herewith repealed.

SECTION FIVE: The invalidity of any article or section thereof of this Ordinance shall not invalidate any other article or ordinance thereof.

SECTION SIX: This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication according to law.
