

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A LOCAL DEFENSE COUNCIL

An Ordinance to establish a Local Defense Council, and providing for the appointment of a Municipal Disaster Control Director,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield in the County of Union:

1. A Local Defense Council is hereby established which shall be composed of no more than fifteen members who shall be appointed by the Mayor and shall hold office at his pleasure.
2. The Mayor shall appoint a municipal disaster control director who shall be a resident of the Township of Winfield and who shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor.
3. The Municipal Disaster Control Director shall appoint a deputy Municipal Disaster Control Director with the approval of the Mayor.
4. The Municipal Disaster Control Director shall be a member of the Defense Council and shall serve as its Chairman.
5. The posts of the Municipal Disaster Control Director, the Assistant Disaster Control Director and the members of the Defense Council shall be unsalaried, except that the Committee of the Township of Winfield may by resolution appropriate the sum of \$150.00 per annum to be paid to the Municipal Disaster Control Director for such services as may be rendered by said Director in said capacity.
6. The Township Committee may adopt rules for the regulation, control and management of the Defense Council pursuant to Chapter 438 PL 1953, an Act concerning civil defense during emergency.
