

ORDER ESTABLISHING POLICE DEPARTMENT

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION, CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT OF A POLICE FORCE.

Be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, in the County of Union:

1. The Police Department of the Township of Winfield aforesaid hereby established shall include such members and officers of the police force thereof as the Township Committee may by resolution appoint.

2. The members and officers of such police force shall receive such pay as the Township Committee may by resolution decide, not to exceed \$4.00 for each day they are actually engaged in performing the duties to which they may be assigned by the Township Committee and they may be dismissed at the will of the Township Committee.

3. The Township Committee may adopt rules for the regulation, control and management of the police force; and such police force shall be under the direction of the director of public safety.

4. This ordinance to take effect immediately.
