AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF MUNICIPAL PROSECUTOR IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD, COUNTY OF UNION, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF WINFIELD TOWNSHIP, NEW JERSEY:

Section 1. CREATION OF OFFICE. There is hereby created in the Township of Winfield the position of Municipal Prosecutor.

Section 2. QUALIFICATIONS. The Municipal Prosecutor shall be an Attorney at Law of the State of New Jersey.

Section 3. APPOINTMENTS. The Municipal Prosecutor shall be appointed for a period of three years by the Township Committee, or as provided by law.

Section 4. DUTIES. The duties of said Municipal Prosecutor shall be to prosecute in the Municipal Court of the Township of Winfield those defendants charged with violation of the statutes of the State of New Jersey or ordinances of the Township of Winfield; said Municipal Prosecutor to appear only in those cases where he may be specifically directed by the Municipal Court Judge to prosecute the action in behalf of the complainant.

Section 5. COMPENSATION. The holder of the position of Municipal Prosecutor shall be paid a salary of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars a year in quarterly installments.

Section 6. SUBSEQUENT RESOLUTIONS. All matters not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 7. LEGALITY. This ordinance shall take effect in the manner prescribed by law.
