AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE FIXING AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR EACH WAGON OR VEHICLE USED IN THE PRODUCTION, DISTRIBUTION, OR SALE OF MILK OR CREAM AND GENERALLY REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD, NEW JERSEY:

Section 1. Section 6 of an Ordinance fixing an annual license fee for each vehicle used in the production, distribution, or sale of milk in the Township of Winfield be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

"Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be subject to a penalty, not exceeding the sum of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars, within the discretion of the Court having juris-diction of the complaint as authorized in Section 24:10-31 of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey."

Section 2. The provisions of all ordinances heretofore adopted and not inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication according to law.
