AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE OBTAINING OF A PERMIT FOR THE TRANSPORTING OR REMOVAL OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of Winfield Township:

SECTION 1. Definitions: as used in this ordinance the following words shall have the meaning herein set forth:

- (a) "truckman" when used in this ordinance shall be taken to include all persons, firms, corporations, and associations which shall transport or remove tangible personal property whether for hire or otherwise and whether or not regularly engaged in such business.
- (b) "person" shall include individuals, companies, firms, societies, co-partnerships, corporations, associations and joint stock companies.

SECTION 2. Every person owning or claiming to own any tangible personal property located in or on any premises in the Township of Winfield, except a warehouse or any person, co-partnership or corporation engaged in the business of storing goods for hire, and who desires to transport or remove the same or cause the same to be transported or removed so that the whole or a substantial part of such properly will be removed or transported from such premises in or on which it is located shall, in person or by agent duly appointed for such purpose, first make written application to the Township Clerk of said Township of Winfield which application shall contain the following information:

- (a) the name and address of the truckman who is to transport or remove such property.
- (b) the name and address of the person owning or claiming to own such property.
- (c) the address of the premises from which, and the address of the premises to which, such property is to be transported or removed; and if either or both such premises be not designated by an address then in lieu thereof such premises shall be clearly identified.

SECTION 3. Such application shall be made between the hours of 9 A.M. and 4 P.M., on any day except holidays, Sundays and Saturdays, provided however, that in case of a bona fide emergency such application may be made at any time.

SECTION 4. The said permit shall be made up in quadruplicate; the original shall be delivered to the applicant; the first copy shall be delivered to the Police Department of the Township of Winfield; and the second copy and third copy shall be retained by the Township Clerk.

SECTION 5. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of \$50.00 or to imprisonment for not more than ninety days, or both, in the dis-

cretion of the Court.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after publication in the manner provided by law.
