shall be physically fit to perform the duties of a fireman
evidenced by a certificate to that effect by a practicing
physician of the State of New Jewsey after phusical examination
for that purpose.

Section 2: The provisions of all ordinances heretofore adopted and not inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately uponfinal adoption and publication according to law.
