Section 9: Section 9 is hereby amended as follows:

Every pool, other than a wading pool, shall be enclosed completely by a safety fence, or a good quality sturdy fence not less; than three (3) feet in height with post embedded in the ground at intervals of not more than eight feet. Any fence attached to the top of the pool must be approved by the Health Officer. Every gate or ladder or other opening in the fence enclosing such pool shall be kept closed and securely locked at all times when the owner or occupant of the premises is not present at such pool. Portable ladders if used in conjunction with the pool, shall be removed when the pool is not in use."
