IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD".


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
WINFIELD, NEW JERSEY:

Section 1: Section 1 is hereby amended as follows:

No person shall hereafter become a member of the Fire Department of the Township of Winfield, or any unit thereof, unless above the age of eighteen (18) and not over the age of forty (40), a citizen of the United States, a resident of the Township of Winfield, County of Union, for upwards of one (1) year. He shall be physically fit to perform the duties of a fireman evidenced by a certificate to that effect by a practicing physician of the State of New Jersey after physical examination for that purpose.
