

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE
ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS
FOR THE PREVENTION OF FIRE, PROTEC-
TION OF LIVES AND PROPERTY IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township
of Winfield in the County of Union:

Article IV, Section 24 of the above entitled ordinance
be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:


Article IV, Section 24. Permits required under the
provisions of this ordinance, as approved by the Fire Chief, shall
be secured from the Township Clerk. In the issuance of permits
for the storage and use of flammable liquids incidental to the
operation of oil burners only one permit shall be secured which
shall continue in full force and effect until there is a material
change in or incidental to such installation. All other permits
shall be effective for a period of one year unless sooner revoked
as herein provided.


This ordinance shall take effect immediately after


