

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the ordinance set forth below was introduced at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield in the County of Union, held on June 21, 1976 and that said ordinance will be further considered for final passage at a meeting of the said Township Committee at the Municipal Headquarters, Gulfstream Avenue, Winfield, New Jersey, on July 6, 1976, at 2:30 o'clock P.M.

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF VARIOUS STREETS BY RESURFACING, REMOVAL OF EXISTING PAVEMENT WHERE NECESSARY, AND INCIDENTAL WORK AS A GENERAL IMPROVEMENT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THEREFORE AND AUTHORIZING THE FINANCING THEREOF.

Section 1. That various streets as set forth in Section 2 shall be improved by resurfacing, removal of existing payment where necessary, removal and replacement of disintergrated curb and incidental work, being approximately 8,350 square yards of resurfacing and 3,800 l.f. of curb replacement.

Section 2. The estimated total cost of the aforementioned projects is as follows:

Atlantic Drive-Wavecrest Avenue to Seafoam Avenue	\$16,250.00
Bob Wilson Place-Wavecrest Avenue to County Road	2,400.00
John Veltoven Terrace-Seafoam Avenue to County Road	2,500.00
Pacific Drive-Gulfstream Avenue to Seafoam Avenue	7,200.00
Spray Terrace-Wavecrest Avenue to Terminus	6,500.00
Winfield Place-Stiles Street to Wavecrest Avenue	2,150.00

Section 3. The said improvement shall be constructed as a general improvement and the cost thereof shall be borne by the Township at Large. Said improvement shall be according to plans, specifications and profiles for said work prepared by the Township Engineer and on file in the Office of the Township Clerk and the same shall be done under the supervision of the Township Engineer.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Thirty Seven Thousand Dollars (\$37,000.00), which sum has been made available by provision in a previously adopted budget of the Township of Winfield.

Section 5. It is hereby determined that the period of usefulness of the aforesaid improvements, the financing of which the aforesaid obligations are hereby issued, is the period of fifteen (15) years.

Section 6. The sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) is stated as the aggregate amount in the cost of the aforesaid improvement for engineering and inspection costs, including advertising in connection therewith.

Section 7. The invalidity or ineffectiveness of any one or more terms or provisions of the foregoing Ordinance, or the inapplicability thereof to any person or circumstances, shall not be deemed to affect the validity and effectiveness of the remaining terms and provisions or the applicability of any term or provision to other persons and circumstances; but each term and provision shall be deemed to be separate and independent.

Section 8. In the event any funds appropriated for any project within this ordinance are not used, then said funds may be used towards any other project included in the within ordinance.


Section 9. All matters relating to the obligations not herein specifically set forth may be determined and provided by subsequent resolutions or as provided by law.

Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect in the manner prescribed by law.
