

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF TOWNSHIP ATTORNEY
FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD, DEFINING THE DUTIES
OF SAME AND FIXING THE SALARY OF THE OFFICE

Be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, Union County, New Jersey:

Sec. 1. The office of Township Attorney is hereby created for this Township.

Sec. 2. The Township Attorney shall attend all meetings of the Township Committee when called upon. He shall advise the Township Committee and the officers of the Township on all matters which may be submitted to him for his opinion. He shall draw such ordinances and resolutions as may be required of him by the Township Committee. He shall prepare leases, obligations, bonds, contracts and other legal instruments relating to the business of the Township, and shall prosecute and defend as counsel for the Township all actions which may be brought by or against it or any officers thereof, or by reason of any matter or duty connected with or growing out of the respective offices or in which the Township is interested in any court of this State whenever thereunto requested by the Township Committee.

Sec. 3. He shall hold office for the term of one year from January 1st of the year of his appointment and until his successor shall have been legally appointed and qualified in his stead.

Sec. 4. He shall receive a salary of \$300.00 per year, payable in equal monthly installments, and such additional compensation as may be equitable and just for all litigated matters, examinations of title and public records, drawing ordinances and resolutions, and all disbursements made by him.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
