

(a) Special policemen and policewomen may be appointed by the Township Committee for such temporary restricted duty as the Chief of Police may assign.

(b) They shall be paid at an hourly rate within the limits of the annual budget.

(c) The appointment of all special policemen and policewomen may be revoked at any time by the Commissioner of Public Safety, upon confirmation by resolution of the Township Committee.

SECTION 8. The Detective Bureau heretofore established in the Police Department pursuant to Section 1, Section 2 and Section 3 of Ordinance No. 59, dated September 14, 1951, and entitled "An Ordinance to Amend an Ordinance Entitled "An Ordinance Establishing a Police Department in the Township of Winfield" in order to Establish in said Department a Detective Bureau" is hereby continued.

SECTION 9. Special Policemen and special policewomen shall not be ranked.

SECTION 10. This Ordinance is to take effect immediately.




