

AN ORDINANCE TO AMMEND AN ORDINANCE "ENTITLED
AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN
OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
WINFIELD"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF WINFIELD, IN THE COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, that
the Ordinance 177-A dated April 17, 1978 fixing the salaries of
certain individuals is hereby ammended as follows:

1. CHIEF OF POLICE - \$18,500 per annum, inclusive of
benefits, to be paid be-monthly.
2. PATROLMAN - An Annual salary not to exceed \$12,500
per annum and annual benefits not to exceed \$2,500
per annum, to be paid bi-monthly.
3. PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS & SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS
to be paid \$3.50 per hour payable bi-monthly.
4. OFFICERS ATTENDING POLICE ACADEMY - \$6.00 per hour
to be paid bi-monthly.


