

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
AND ESTABLISHING THE DUTIES OF SAID POSITION

WHEREAS, the day to day demands of the administrative governmental affairs of the Township of Winfield, County of Union, State of New Jersey, upon the time of the members of the Township Committee has grown to the extent that it has become increasingly difficult to devote adequate time to the charge of the duties of Environmental Protection; and

WHEREAS, a proper regard for the public interest in the area of environmental and economic protection of the Township requires the creation of a position which will furnish to the members of the Township Committee the necessary assistance in the prompt day to day management of environmental affairs of the Township and the coordination of the activities of its affairs, departments, and in the assistance and planning supervising the execution of the work of the governing body of said Township;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, State of New Jersey as follows:


Section 1. There is hereby created the position of DIRECTOR of the Department of Environmental Protection.


Section 2. The Director of the Department of Environmental Protection shall be appointed by the majority vote of the Township Committee and shall hold office for a term of one year. The Director of Environmental Protection shall serve without compensation.


Section 3. The Director of the Department of Environmental Protection shall under the supervision and control of the Township Committee, perform such duties as may be requested from time to time by the governing body. Such duties may include, but not be limited to the area of Environmental Protection with respect to the coordination of operations, activities, and administration of the departments, divisions, offices, boards, and agencies of the Township government exchanging and disseminating information and generally coordinating and consulting with the Township Committee without infringing upon the lawful powers and duties of other officers, Boards, and Departments.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts thereof, or resolutions inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after publication in the manner provided by law.


