ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF CLERK OF RECORDER'S COURT FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD AND DEFINING HIS DUTIES

Be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, Union County, New Jersey:

- 1. There is hereby established the office of Clerk of the Township Recorder's Court for this Township.
- 2. The Clerk of the Recorder's Court shall keep all records of the Recorder's Court, attend all hearings and trials in the Recorder's Court and take minutes of the proceedings and perform all the usual duties of a clerk of a Magistrate's Court.
- 3. He shall draw a salary for said services as fixed by ordinance.
- 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
