

ORDINANCE REQUIRING CURBING  
OF DOGS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, there have been complaints received by this governing body regarding the excessive amount of dog excrement on school property and especially on playgrounds; and

WHEREAS, this condition presents a serious threat to the health of the persons who work for the Winfield School Systems and especially for the students and other children who play on the school property; and


WHEREAS, this Township Committee desires to eliminate this health hazard;

NOW BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield as follows;

Section 1. Any person who walks their dogs or any other household pets on property owned by the Board of Education and permit them to litter on such property must immediately remove the excrement from the grounds or be in violation of this ordinance.

Section 2. Persons adjudged guilty of a violation of this ordinance shall be fined a maximum of \$150.00 for each separate violation.


Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
