ORDINANCE FIXING SALARIES OF TOWNSHIP CLERK, TOWNSHIP TREASURER, TOWNSHIP RECORDER, COURT CLERK AND TOWNSHIP COMMITTEEMEN.

This ordinance as entitled above passed by the Township Committee, July 26, 1943 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, County of Union and State of New Jersey, that the salaries attached to the offices of Township Clerk, Township Treasurer, Township Recorder, Court Clerk and Township Committeemen shall be and are hereby fixed respectively as follows:

The salaries fixed by the foregoing section of this ordinance shall be payable at the rates therein fixed in equal semi-annual installments. Said respective salaries shall be in lieu of any and all fees to which the respective incumbents of said offices might otherwise be entitled by statute or ordinance, which fees shall immediately, upon collection thereof be paid over to the township treasurer for the use of the township.
