ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE FIND THAT THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED BICYCLES, COMMONLY KNOWN AS "MOPEDS" ON SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD PRESENTS AN UNWARRANTED RISK OF INJURY AND FEAR OF INJURY TO PEDESTRIANS USING SAID SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC AREAS.
- 2. NO MOTORIZED BICYCLE SHALL BE OPERATED UPON OR WITHIN ANY SIDEWALK WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD.
- 3. ANY PERSON VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF UP TO ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS.

4. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AFTER FINAL PASSAGE UPON PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
