

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF,
THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The owner, agent, tenant, occupant or person having charge of any building or lands bordering upon any street, square, highway or public place within the Township of Winfield, that is or may be graded, curbed and flagged, shall cause the sidewalk in front of said property to be cleared of snow, ice or sleet to a width of the sidewalk, within twelve (12) hours of daylight after the same shall be formed or fall thereon.

SECTION 2. The owner or agent having charge of any street or roadway, within this Township shall cause said streets or roadways to be cleared of snow, or in the case of ice or sleet, make provision for the proper movement of traffic, within twelve (12) hours of daylight after the same shall be formed or fall thereon.

SECTION 3. Whenever ice shall form on any sidewalk or any part thereof, the owner, agent, tenant, occupant or person having charge of any building or lands as aforesaid shall, within the space of one (1) hour thereafter, during the daytime, cause such sidewalk to be made safe and convenient for travel, by removing the ice therefrom, or by covering the same with sand or some other suitable substance. Use of salt is not permissible.

SECTION 4. The owner, agent, tenant, occupant or person having charge of any building or lands bordering on any street, square, highway or public place in the Township of Winfield where there is any footway or sidewalk having a paved gutter, shall at all times keep such paved gutter free from snow, ice or sleet, so as to permit the free passage of water through the same.

SECTION 5. No person shall sweep, throw or deposit any snow or ice in that part of the street or highway which has or is being plowed, swept, cleaned or cleared in the municipality for the passage of traffic.

SECTION 6. The owner, agent, tenant, occupant or person having charge of any building or lands as aforesaid, whose duty it is to clear the sidewalk and gutters opposite thereto, who shall violate any of the provisions of the foregoing sections, or refuse or neglect to comply with same, shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than two dollars for each offense and not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for any subsequent offense.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent

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with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
