AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING HANDICAPPED PARKING PERMITS

 $\,$ BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield as follows:

- 1. The Township Committee hereby establishes the practice and procedure required for a resident of Winfield Township to obtain in front of or near his or her home a restricted parking sign for handicapped persons.
- 2. Township Committee hereby establishes a committee to be called the 'Handicapped Residents Review Committee'. Said Committee shall consist of the Superintendent of Public Works, Chief of Police, the Township Nurse, and a Township Resident who shall review all applications by residents of Winfield Township seeking a reserved restricted handicapped parking sign in front of or near the resident's home.
- 4. The said Committee shall report on all said applications to the Township Committee and shall either recommend that the handicapped parking place be apported or denied.
- 5. The Township Committee is hereby empowered by Resolution to grant such requests for handicapped parking signs as in its determination are necessary and proper. The Township Committee is not bound by the recommendations of the Handicapped Residents Review Committee in reaching its conclusion.
- 6. Any person, firm or corporation which violates this Ordinance shall upon conviction, be punishable of a fine having a minimum of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) and a maximum fine not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).
 - 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
