

SUPPLEMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 21 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE
CONCERNING HEALTH IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD".

Be it ordained by the Board of Health of the Township of Winfield, County of Union, and State of New Jersey:

SECTION 12: The Manager, Board of Trustees, of the Mutual Housing Corporation or both, having full jurisdiction over the Streets and Playgrounds of Winfield, shall be responsible for the proper cleanliness thereof. They shall supply waste-paper containers and place them in various parts of the Community in accordance with the request of the Department of Health.


The Play Sand-boxes shall be cleaned out at least once each year, preferably in the Spring, and before the children make use of them. The boxes shall be filled with fresh sand and the surrounding grounds kept clean and free of accumulated debris. It shall be the duty of the Manager or Members of the Board of Trustees of the Mutual Housing Corporation to keep said play area in a healthful and sanitary condition at all times.

SECTION 13: The Manager, Board of Trustees of the Mutual Housing Corporation or both, shall be held responsible for the proper upkeep and maintenance of all matters over which they have jurisdiction and of which any neglect on their part would be hazardous to the general health of the Community. Provisions shall be made whereby the repairs or adjustments can be carried out within a reasonable time after the trouble is reported. Whether at night, week-end or holiday. No family shall be left without running water any longer than the reasonable time required to make the necessary repairs. Broken sewer lines shall be repaired immediately and as soon as the material for replacement becomes available. At no time shall an unsanitary condition be allowed to exist that would jeopardize the health of the citizens.

SECTION 14: Any person, persons, firm or corporation offending against or violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, pay a penalty of not less than ten dollars for the first offense nor more than fifty dollars for the second offense and for each subsequent offense not more than one hundred dollars.

SECTION 15: All ordinances or part of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 16: This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
