## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT WINFIELD ORDINANCE # 252

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD A MANDATORY PROGRAM FOR THE SEPARATION OF (USED NEWSPAPERS, GLASS, ALUMINUM CANS, AND YARD WASTE) FROM HOUSEHOLD SOLID WASTE, THE COLLECTION OF SUCH (USED NEWSPAPERS, GLASS, ALUMINUM CANS, AND YARD WASTE) FROM RESIDENCES FOR RECYCLING PURPOSES, PROMULGATING RULES AND REGULATIONS THEREFORE, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Township of Winfield that:

Section 2 of Ordinance # 252 is amended to read as follows:

Section 2: Regulations Authorized:

Said Coordinator is hereby authorized and directed to propose regulations as to the manner, days and times of such collections and the bundling, handling, location, and time of placement of all materials for collection for the approval of the Township Committee.

This amendment shall take effect upon publication and final passage in a manner prescribed by law.
