

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 191
REQUIRING CURBING OF DOGS


BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield that Ordinance No. 191 is amended as follows:

Section 1. Any person who walks their dogs or any other household pets on property owned by the Board of Education and permit them to litter on such property must immediately remove the excrement from the grounds or be in violation of this ordinance.

Section 2. Any person who walks their dogs or any other household pets on any common thoroughfare, sidewalk, passageway, or upon any place where people congregate or upon any public property whatsoever and permits them to litter on such property must immediately remove the excrement from the grounds or be in violation of this ordinance.

Section 3. Persons adjudged guilty of a violation of this ordinance shall be fined a maximum of \$150.00 for each separate violation.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.


