ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH REQUIREMENTS REGULATING NOISE POLLUTION

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT NOISE LEVELS WHICH ARE INJURIOUS TO PUBLIC PEACE AND ORDER

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, as follows:

- 1. No person operating a motor vehicle or any passenger in a motor vehicle in the Township of Winfield shall permit a radio or other musical device to emit noise which is so loud so as to disturb the quiet enjoyment of property in residential areas in the community.
- Any person charged with a violation of the within ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be subject to a fine not exceeding \$200.00 dollars.
- 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
- 4. If any section or provision in this ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid such adjudication shall apply to the section or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
