

SUPPLEMENT TO AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING DOGS, CATS AND OTHER
DOMESTICATED ANIMALS.

SECTION #22: It shall be the duty of every owner or person that harbors a dog to have said animal inoculated against rabies. The inoculation shall be done by a reputable veterinarian who shall use the recognized anti-rabies serum for this purpose. This section shall become effective immediately and the citizens of this Township shall be duly informed of this measure by flyer or newspaper. All dogs within the limits of this Township shall be inoculated against rabies within 15 days after passage.

SECTION #23: Following the establishment of this Ordinance it shall be the duty of every owner or person that harbors a dog to have said animal inoculated against rabies each year. A person who fails to provide this necessary protection shall be deemed unqualified to receive a dog license and it shall be the duty of the Township Clerk or any other person assigned to issue dog licenses to refuse to issue same until a signed and written proof is furnished. Failure to comply with this section and the previous section shall be considered an offense punishable within the provisions of this Ordinance.
