AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF A QUESTION FOR REFERENDUM ON THE GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, County of Union. State of New Jersey, that a question be caused to be placed on the General Election Ballot for referendum, and that the Township Clerk forward a certified copy of same to the officer whose duty it is to prepare the ballots for election.

SECTION 1. The following is the question to be placed on the Ballot:

"Shall the salaries of the members of the Township Committee of this Township of Winfield, Union County, New Jersey, be \$1.00 per annum, each"?

SECTION 2. As soon as the desire of the citizens of this Township has been made known, the Township Committee shall take immediate steps to pass an Ordinance providing for such payment of salaries, and said salaries shall commence on the first day of January, 1949.
