AN ORDINANCE TO SUPPLEMENT AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION, CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT OF A POLICE FORCE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD, NEW JERSEY, ADOPTED MARCH 1, 1943".

All ordinances fixing the salaries of the employees of the Police Department of the Township of Winfield, heretofore passed and adopted by the Township Committee, are hereby revised and amended to read as follows:

- 1. The officers and members of the Police Department of Winfield, shall: when they are actually engaged in performing the duties to which they may be assigned by the Commissioner of Public Safety or the Chief of Police or, when they receive a subpoena as a witness in a matter arising out of or pursuant to their duties, shall receive such compensation as the Township may by Resolution determine and decide to be commensurate with, but not in excess of, the salary or remuneration by the officers and members of the said Police Department in their regular or accustomed occupation or employment.
- 2. The officers and members of the Police Department of the Township of Winfield may be dismissed in accordance with and pursuant to the provisions of the Rules and Regulations adopted February 3, 1947, as amended.
