

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR RENOVATIONS TO THE  
JAMES F. BUCKLE SENIOR CITIZEN CENTER, ROOSEVELT DR.,  
WINFIELD, NEW JERSEY**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield in the County of Union, New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the Township be permitted to renovate the James F. Buckle Senior Citizen Center, Roosevelt Dr., Winfield, NJ.

**SECTION 2.** The estimated cost to the Township of Winfield for the aforementioned project is One Hundred Twelve Thousand One Hundred Eighty Five Dollars (\$112,185.00).

**SECTION 3.** The said improvement shall be considered a general improvement and the cost thereof shall be borne by the Township of Winfield at large.

**SECTION 4.** There is hereby appropriated the sum of One Hundred Twelve Thousand One Hundred Eighty Five Dollars (\$112,185.00), of which the sum of \$20,000.00 has been made available in the Capital Improvement Fund of a previously adopted budget of the Township of Winfield and \$10,000.00 from the Capital Surplus Fund. Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) shall be provided by Community Development Block Grant Account # 001.541 and the balance of \$52,185 provided by the County of Union Senior Focus Grant.

**SECTION 5.** It is hereby determined that the period of usefulness of the aforesaid improvement, the financing of which the aforesaid obligations are hereby issued, is the period of fifteen years (15), and that the obligations authorized by this Ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by the laws of the State of New Jersey.

**SECTION 6.** The full faith and credit of the Township of Winfield, New Jersey, are hereby pledged for the payment of the principal interest on all of the bonds or notes issued pursuant to this ordinance, and the sums required for such payment shall, in each year while said bonds or notes are outstanding, be included in the annual budget and raised by taxes levied upon all taxable property within said Township without limits to rate or amount.

**SECTION 7.** The invalidity or ineffectiveness of any one or more terms or provisions of the foregoing Ordinance, or the inapplicability thereof to any person or circumstances, shall not be deemed to affect the validity and effectiveness of the remaining terms and provisions or the applicability or any terms or provisions to other persons and circumstances; each term and provision shall be deemed to be separate and independent.


**SECTION 8.** All matters relating to the obligations not herein specifically set forth be determined and provided by subsequent resolutions or as provided by law.

**SECTION 9.** The Capital Budget of the Township of Winfield is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance for the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended Capital Budget Program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services and are on file with the Township Clerk and are for public inspection.

**SECTION 10.** This Ordinance shall take effect in the manner prescribed by law.






