AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REVISE "ALL ORDINANCES FIXING SALARIES OF TOWNSHIP CLERK, TOWNSHIP TREASURER, TOWNSHIP TAX ASSESSOR, TOWNSHIP TAX COLLECTOR".

The respective salaries of the respective offices fixed by this ordinance shall be in payment of any and all services rendered by the persons holding the offices herein referred to in discharging the duties of their respective offices as prescribed by law, and all fees to which the respective encumbents or appointees might otherwise be entitled by statutes or ordinance, shall immediately upon collection thereof, be paid over to the Township Treasurer for the use of the Township.
