

ORDINANCE CONCERNING INFLAMMABLE OR COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE, STORAGE AND SALE OF INFLAMMABLE OR COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS AND TO PROVIDE FOR INSPECTION OF BUILDINGS, WAREHOUSES AND OTHER PLACES AND MATERIALS CONTAINED THEREIN.

Be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, Union County, New Jersey that:

1. No person shall store, use or sell inflammable or combustible materials within this Township without a written permit or license obtained from the Township authorities.

2. Such license shall be issued by the Township Clerk upon the payment of a fee of Five (\$5.00) Dollars and the license shall be good for a period of one (1) year from the date of issuance.

3. The holder of such license, heretofore mentioned, shall exhibit same upon the premises where the said inflammable or combustible materials are stored.

4. The said licensee shall, at all times, permit the inspection of buildings, warehouses and other places where inflammable or combustible materials are stored to a Township Inspector, or to any representative of the Township Fire Department.

5. Any person violating or causing to be violated, any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable or subject to a fine not exceeding <sup>Two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or imprisonment of</sup> thirty (30) days in the county jail, or both, in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided.

6. Any complaint regarding the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be cognizable before the Recorder's Court of the Township of Winfield.

7. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
