AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT VICE, DRUNKENNESS AND IMMORALITY,
TO PRESERVE THE PUBLICE PEACE AND ORDER, TO PREVENT AND QUELL
RIOTS, DISTURBANCES AND DISORDERLY ASSEMBLAGES.

Be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, Union County, New Jersey that:

- 1. No person shall keep or maintain a disorderly house or house of ill-fame within the limits of this Township.
- 2. No person shall permit any premises, within this Township, to be frequented by riotous or disorderly persons, gamblers, vagrants or common mendicants.
- 3. No person shall make or assist in any riot or other disturbance in or about any premises in this Township where dancing or other amusements are permitted.
- 4. No person shall make, aid, countenance or assist in improper noise, riot, disturbance or breach of peace and no person shall collect in bodies or crowds for idle and unlawful purposes to the annoyance or disturbance of citizens or residents of this Township.
- 5. No person shall appear in a public or private place in an intoxicated condition to the annoyance of any other person or persons.
- 6. Any person violating or causing to be violated, any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable or subject to a fine not exceeding Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars or imprisonment not exceeding sixty (60) days in the county jail, or both, in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided.
- 7. Any complaint regarding the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be cognizable before the Recorder's Court of the Township of Winfield.

8. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
