

AN ORDINANCE TO FIX THE COMPENSATION OF THE NURSE AND
HEALTH INSPECTOR OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF WINFIELD.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield:


SECTION 1: The nurse duly appointed by the Board of Health of the Township of Winfield shall receive as compensation for her services in that position the sum of Nine Hundred (\$900.00) Dollars per annum and which sum shall be payable out of the funds of the Township of Winfield by the Treasurer thereof in twelve equal installments.



SECTION 2: The Health Inspector duly appointed by the Board of Health of the Township of Winfield shall receive as compensation for his services in that position the sum of Two Hundred Eighty (\$280.00) Dollars per annum and which sum shall be payable out of the funds of the Township of Winfield by the Treasurer thereof in twelve equal installments.

SECTION 3: The compensation herein provided shall be in full payment of any and all services rendered to the Township of Winfield by the officials mentioned and any fees or other sums of money received by the persons holding said positions while in the performance of their official duties shall be considered the property of the Township of Winfield and properly deposited with the funds of the Township of Winfield in such banking institution as may be designated by the Township Committee.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
