AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE PARKING ON A PART OF THE NORTHERLY SIDE LINES OF GULFSTREAM AVENUE

SECTION 1: That parking at any time on the northerly side line of
Gulfstream Avenue commencing at a point 100 feet from the corner formed by the intersection of the easterly side line of Pacific Drive with the northerly side line of
Gulfstream Avenue and extending along Gulfstream Avenue in an easterly direction for
a distance of 40 feet is hereby prohibited, except for the use of space mentioned,
for parking purposes, by motor vehicles operated by persons having official business
in the municipal offices of the Township of Winfield, and that parking at any time on
the northerly side line of Gulfstream commencing at a point 140 feet from the corner
formed by the intersection of the easterly side line of Pacific Drive with the northerly side line of Gulfstream Avenue and extending along Gulfstream Avenue in an
easterly direction for a distance of 135 feet be and the same is hereby prohibited,
except for the use of the space mentioned, for parking purposes, by official police
and fire vehicles owned by the Township of Winfield.

SECTION 2: For any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance any offender shall be subject to a fine of not more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) days or both such fine and imprisonment within the discretion of the Court having jurisdiction of the complaint.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption and publication according to law.
