

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR EACH WAGON OR VEHICLE USED IN THE PRODUCTION, DISTRIBUTION, OR SALE OF MILK OR CREAM AND GENERALLY REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Township of Winfield:

SECTION 1. Each person, firm or corporation engaged within the corporate limits of the Township of Winfield in the production, distribution or sale of milk or cream shall pay an annual license fee in the sum of Two (\$2.00) Dollars for each store, wagon or vehicle used in such production, distribution or sale as authorized by Section 24:10-24 of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 2. The person, firm or corporation desiring such license shall make an application therefor in writing and which application shall state the full name and address of the applicant; the municipality from which the milk or cream to distributed by him is procured and the name and address of each person from whom such milk or cream is to be obtained and the application shall be signed by the applicant.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation securing such license shall immediately notify the Board, in writing, of any change in the source of his supply of milk or cream and shall also notify the Board, in writing, immediately of the change in the name of any person supplying them such milk or cream.

SECTION 4. No license shall be granted to any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of the Statutes of the State of New Jersey concerning the production, sale or distribution of milk or cream and the license of any person, firm or corporation shall be revoked by this Board if any such licensee shall sell, produce or distribute any milk or cream in violation of any of the provisions of the Statutes of the State of New Jersey regulating the production, sale or Distribution of milk or cream.

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or corporation engaged in the production, distribution or sale of milk or cream who shall also produce, distribute or sell other merchandise or products from the vehicles herein referred to shall secure such other license or license as may be required by the ordinances of this Township.

SECTION 6: Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be subject to a penalty, not exceeding the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, within the discretion of the Court having jurisdiction of the complaint as authorized in Section 24:10-31 of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 7: The part or parts of any Ordinance inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 8: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
