AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD" IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH IN SAID DEPARTMENT A DETECTIVE BUREAU.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established in the Police Department of the Township of Winfield a"Detective Bureau."

SECTION 2. There shall be appointed and assigned to said Bureau as herein after indicated not more than three(3) members of the Police Department of the Township of Winfield.

SECTION. 3. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as preventing the Township Committee or the Director of Public Safety upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police of assigning to said Bureau from time to time on a temporary basis such members of the Police Department as may be required to meet any general or emergency condition arising in this Department or required for the protection of the welfare and safety of the residents of the Township of Winfield.

SECTION 4. Any person or persons assigned to such Bureau from the Police Department shall not receive any compensation, but shall receive reimbursement as provided in the ordinance supplementing compensation provisions contained in Ordinance N. 11 and which supplementing ordinance was adopted by the Township Committee as Ordinance No. 34.

SECTION 5. The Township Committee by resolution shall designate the members of said Department assigned to duty in said Eureau upon the recommendation of the Chief of the Department and the Director of Public Safety.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
