

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING HEALTH IN THE  
TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD

No person or persons shall keep or harbor, horses, cows, sheep, goats, pigs, guniea pigs, rabbits, or fowl in the Township of Winfield.

No person or persons shall keep dogs or cats in the cellar of any multiple dwelling in the Township of Winfield in such a manner or under conditions that are or may become objectionable to the other occupants of said dwelling.

Any ordinance or parts of this ordinance that conflict with in full or in part are hereby repealed.
