

ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND PROHIBIT THE SALE AND USE OF
GUNS, PISTOLS, ETC.

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND PROHIBIT THE SALE AND USE OF GUNS, PISTOLS, FIRE ARMS, AND FIRE WORKS.

Be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield, Union County, New Jersey that:

1. No person, firm or corporation shall sell or use guns, pistols, fire arms or fire works within this Township without having previously obtained a permit for same from the Township authorities.
2. Such permit shall be issued by the Township Clerk upon the payment of a fee of One (\$1.00) Dollar and the license shall be good for a period of one (1) year from the date of issuance thereof.
3. Any person violating or causing to be violated, any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable or subject to a fine not exceeding Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars or imprisonment not exceeding ten (10) days in the county jail, or both, in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided.
4. Any complaint regarding the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be cognizable before the Recorder's Court of the Township of Winfield.
5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
