

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE "PROVIDING  
FOR THE REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE IN THE TOWN-  
SHIP OF WINFIELD AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR  
THE VIOLATION THEREOF."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of  
Winfield:

SECTION 1: Section 6 of the ordinance of which this is an  
amendment is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance  
shall upon conviction be subject to a fine not exceeding  
One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or imprisonment in the County  
Jail for a period not exceeding Ninety (90) days, or both  
such fine and imprisonment, within the discretion of the  
Court having jurisdiction of the complaint.

SECTION 2. The ordinance hereby amended is commonly known as  
Ordinance No. 23 of the Township of Winfield.
