

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED  
 "SUPPLEMENT TO AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING DOGS,  
 CATS AND OTHER DOMESTICATED ANIMALS".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Township of Winfield that Sections 22 and 23 of the above ordinance are hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 22: In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Township of Winfield and persons generally having lawful business therein it is the opinion of this Board that an annual program for the voluntary inoculation of dogs should be continued in the Township and for that purpose the officers of the Board shall make the necessary arrangements for such inoculation services to be available to the owners of dogs residing within the corporate limits of the Township of Winfield at least once in each year at such time in each year as satisfactory arrangements may be made for the inoculation and the Secretary of this Board shall properly notify the residents of the Township by public advertisement or otherwise of the time and place of such inoculation service.

SECTION 23: The owners of all dogs residing within the corporate limits of the Township of Winfield are hereby urged for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township and the persons having lawful business therein to avail themselves of the inoculation service aforementioned and to cooperate in the voluntary inoculation of all dogs owned by them.
