


AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT CRUELTY TO ANIMALS

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT CRUELTY TO ANIMALS.

The Township Committee of the Township of Winfield,
Union County, New Jersey do ordain:

1. No person shall inhumanly, unnecessarily or cruelly beat, injure or otherwise abuse any dumb animal.
2. Authority is hereby given to any Township Officer to place under arrest any person found violating Section No.1 of this ordinance.
3. Any person found guilty of violating or causing to be violated Section No. 1 of this ordinance shall be liable or subject to a fine not exceeding Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars or imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed ten (10) days or both.
4. Any complaint regarding the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be cognizable before the Recorder's Court of the Township of Winfield.
5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
