

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED
 "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE OFFICE OF
 TOWNSHIP AUDITOR FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD,
 COUNTY OF UNION, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
 PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A TOWNSHIP
 AUDITOR AND PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES OF HIS
 OFFICE, FEES FOR HIS SERVICES And QUALIFICATIONS
 FOR CONSIDERATION FOR SAID OFFICE".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of
 Winfield, County of Union, State of New Jersey:

SECTION 1: Section 5 of the Ordinance entitled as above and
 commonly known as Ordinance No. 30, and Ordinance No. 65, of the
 Township of Winfield, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5: The Township Auditor shall receive a salary
 of \$1,000.00 per year in equal quarterly installments.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent
 herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon
 publication and final adoption according to law.
