

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF CARETAKER AND JANITOR FOR THE TOWNSHIP OFFICES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD, FIXING THE SALARY THEREOF AND DEFINING THE QUALIFICATIONS AND DUTIES THEREOF."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Winfield:

SECTION 1: Section 2 of the ordinance entitled as above and commonly known as Ordinance No. 56 of the Township of Winfield is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 2: The salary of said position is hereby fixed at the sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1,200.00) Dollars per annum, payable in semi-monthly installments by the Treasurer of the Township of Winfield."

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication and final adoption according to law.
